The history of the institution dates back to October 28th 1952 when the foundation stone of a TB sanatorium was laid by the Governor of Punjab. The TB sanatorium was inaugurated by Dr.Rajendra Prasad, the first president of India, on May 21st 1958. The first batch of medical students was admitted in 1998. Post graduation courses were started in 2010. The institute currently boasts of 827 bedded hospital including a Super Speciality Block & a state of art auditorium with a seating capacity of 800.

DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY MEDICINE

Since the inception of the institute, the Department of Community Medicine (previously known as Dept. of Preventive & Social Medicine) has been a key department at Dr. RPGMC Kangra at Tanda. The Department aims to produce high quality public health professionals and community physicians. The department has always remained a strong pillar in dealing with diseases of public health importance, especially during epidemics and outbreaks.

The department is credited with successfully conducting various research projects under ICMR, NHM and WHO

How to get here:

•Air: The nearest airport is Gaggal which is 10 kms from Tanda. Daily flights of Spice Jet and Air India connect Kangra with New Delhi

•Rail: The nearest Rail head is Pathankot which is well connected with all the major cities of the country. A Toy Train (narrow gauge) also runs from Pathankot to Joginder Nagar, Kangra is a station on this route.

•Road: Tanda is located alongside NH 20 to which bus and taxi services are available from Pathankot and neighbouring towns/cities. The nearest bus stop is Kangra, which is 4 Kms from the institute.

KANGRA: THE LAND OF TEMPLES

1. Brajeshwari Mata Temple (5 Kms): This temple was built by Pandavas at the behest of Goddess Durga. Legend says that after Goddess Sati sacrificed herself Lord Vishnu divided her body into 51 parts and her left breast fell at this spot thus making it a Shaktipeeth.

 2. Baijnath Shiva Temple (45 Kms): History says that Lord Shiva is present in the form of Shiva Linga here which was established here by Ravana and worshipped to achieve immortality.
3. Jawalamukhi Mata Temple (35 Kms): An ancient temple also mentioned in Mahabharta and other scriptures. There is a natural cave where eternal flames continues to burn.

4. Masroor Rock cut Temple (40 Kms): These early 8th century temples were carved out of monolithic rock and provided with a sacred pool of water as recommended by Hindu texts on the temple architecture.

5. Chamunda Devi Temple (15 Kms): The place where two great demons 'Chand" and 'Mund" were killed by goddess Kali.

6. Chintpurni Mata mandir (55 Kms): Mata mandir is a prominent pilgrimage center & one of the 7 major Shakti Peethas in India. It is believed that Mata Sati's head fell at this place & is thus considered one of the most important Shakti Peethas.





TOURIST ATTRACTIONS

DHARAMSHALA

One of the best places in India to beat the heat during the summer season. It is famous for numerous Buddhist Monastries. It has one of the most beautiful International cricket stadiums in the world surrounded with picturesque snow clad Dhauladhar Range.

MCLEODGANJ (9 KM.)

Also known as Little Lhasa, it is the abode of His Holiness The Dalai Lama. Mcleodganj is one of the few places in India where one can witness a perfect blend of Indian and Tibetan cultures living in harmony with each other. This hill town boasts of exquisite trekking trails, soothing weather conditions, idyllic landscape and vibrant culture.

PALAMPUR (30 KM)

A hill station famous for its tea gardens surrounded by pine forests and Dhauladhar ranges.

BIR BILLING (60 KM.)

An international paragliding destination that has also hosted a world cup in 2015. It is a famous tourist destination. This event would provide a great opportunity of paragliding to delegates.

PONG DAM LAKE/ MAHARANA PRATAP SAGAR (50 KM.)

It is the highest earthfill dam in India situated on Beas River. It is a world famous bird sanctuary which always attracts bird lovers from around the world. This lake is also famous for all types of water sports.
